The company immediately reported the error to the California Air Resources Board (CARB) and corrected the issue. World Energy is fully supportive of CARB's resolution of this matter, its continuing efforts to maintain the integrity of the LCFS program and its mission to drive the world toward a more sustainable future.

World Energy is one of the largest and longest-serving advanced biofuel suppliers in North America. Founded in 1998, the company operates biodiesel manufacturing plants in Houston, Texas, Natchez, Miss., Rome, Ga., Harrisburg, Pa., and Hamilton, Ont. In Paramount, Calif. the company operates a renewable diesel refinery and the first commercial sustainable aviation fuel (SAF) facility in the world.
