We also appreciate your recent efforts related to monitoring and enforcement based on the investigations of specific emitters. The City would like to work with SCAQMD on additional control measures for any metal forging facility that has a violation history to further protect the residents and schools in Paramount.

Beyond that, and based on California Health & Safety Code § 40449 (b), the City is requesting that SCAQMD conduct a full Health Risk Assessment, including hexavalent chromium and other TACs listed on AB2588, when it comes to all metal forging facilities within the boundaries of the City. This, we feel, will provide the best protection for sensitive individuals such as those at homes and schools in close proximity to metal forging facilities.

We appreciate all of SCAQMD's efforts to date and are looking forward to working closely with your staff to ensure that we are protecting the health and safety of our residents.
