The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) has reviewed the CAM 17 metals and Chromium VI sampling results titled "Site Investigation Report, Village Park" dated June 2, 2017. The soil and dust sampling results are for the Paramount Village Park prepared by Tetra Tech, Inc.

DTSC's review indicate that concentrations detected in the soil and dust at the Paramount Village Park are below screening levels for all metals except for Arsenic's concentrations that are below background levels for the Paramount area. DTSC agrees with the report's recommendation that no further action is necessary for the Park.
